(a) Legally required number of full-time faculty members

There are 177 full-time faculty members (79 professors) for the capacity of 1,868 undergraduate students. This complies with the legal standard (110 faculty members, with 60 of them being professors, required). There are 283 research advisors (175 professors) and 84 assistant research advisors for the capacity of 663 graduate students. This complies with the legal standard (58 research advisors, with 41, 42 or 43 of them being professors, and 16 assistant research advisors required).
