About the COIL Project

Sophia University, Ochanomizu University and University of Shizuoka were jointly selected as one of the Japanese universities to promote Collaborative Online International Learning (COIL) between US and Japan. In partnership with ten American universities, the project aims to utilize COIL as means to enhance multicultural learning as well as to tackle with educational inequality on different levels.

About the Symposium

The symposium consists of: 1. Introduction of the project and its significance to higher education in Japan and US; 2. Lectures by two key international partners, American Council on Education (ACE) on COIL initiatives in US, and Jesuit Worldwide Learning (JWL) for its mission on higher education at the margins; and 3. Discussion on possibilities of COIL for international and multicultural education.

The event is open to the public as an opportunity to learn and discuss about the new initiatives among various stakeholders.

当事業は、オンライン国際協働教育(COIL)を利用した遠隔教育と交流事業を軸に、上智大学、お茶の水女子大学、静岡県立大学が米国10大学との2国間の大学連携を図ります。『人間の安全保障と多文化共生』を事業テーマとし、学生へのグローバル教育機会の提供、連携大学と地域社会のリソースを活用した多層的な学生交流の促進、COILの第三国への展開を通じた途上国の教育格差是正への貢献を目指します。

シンポジウム概要

当シンポジウムは、1) 事業概要と日米の高等教育におけるCOILの重要性、2) 米国教育協議会(ACE)による米国におけるCOIL活用に関する講演、難民キャンプなど周縁地における高等教育機会提供の取り組みをおこなっている Jesuit Worldwide Learning (JWL)の講演、3) COILが国際教育・多文化教育にもたらす可能性に関するパネルディスカッション、にて構成されています。

また当シンポジウムは、オンラインを使った国際 教育や国内3大学と米国10大学間の連携といった、 新しい試みを国内の教育機関他関係者に周知す ることを目的として、広く一般に公開されます。
